

Protection policy of personal data

Berlina, s.r.o. is strongly committed to privacy issues, and this privacy statement details our approach on such issues.

Collection of personal data

We only collect identifiable personal data or information that is specifically and voluntarily provided by participants of individual professional events, or participants within the cooperation to Berlina, s.r.o.. We receive limited identifiable information, such as full name, title, company address, e-mail address, and telephone and fax numbers. Typically, identifying information is collected to:

- Register for certain areas of the Berlina, s.r.o. individual activities
- Enquire for further information
- Distribute requested reference materials

Using personal data

Personal data provided to us, we will use only for the purposes for which it was provided to us as stated at the point of collection (or as is obvious from the context of collection). Examples of the types of use are given in the 'data collection' section above. Collected data we do not collect or compile for dissemination or sale to outside parties for consumer marketing purposes, or host mailings on behalf of third parties.

Data controller

Berlina, s.r.o. (the limited liability company registered in Slovakia under ID registration no. 50 122 681 and with its registered address at Donnerova 7, 841 04 Bratislava, the Slovak Republic), is the data controller of any personal data collected through this website, and will process such data in accordance with the Act No. 122/2013 Coll. on Personal Data Protection as amended.

Disclosure to third parties

We recognise that your information is valuable and we take all reasonable measures to protect your information while it is in our care.

Personal data which has been submitted to Berlina, s.r.o. Your personal information may also be transferred to third party service providers who process information on Berlina's, s.r.o. behalf, including providers of information technology, identity management, website hosting and management, data analysis, data back-up, security and storage services.

Security

We are ensuring you, that we have implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security in order to protect personally identifiable data and information from loss, misuse, alteration or destruction. In particular, we ensure that all appropriate confidentiality obligations and technical and organisational security measures are in place to prevent any unauthorised or unlawful disclosure or processing of such information and data and the accidental loss or destruction of or damage to such information and data. Only authorised Berlina, s.r.o. personnel are provided access to personally identifiable information and these employees have agreed to ensure confidentiality of this information. Berlina, s.r.o. policy is to use data for its publication, communication and realization activities.
